Attached below are the project proposal form instructions. Submitting a proposal online is the preferred method of submission. If an online submission is not possible, we will certainly accept hard copy submissions.

Organizations submitting a proposal will need a WOV sponsor to guide the application process. If the organization needs to identify a sponsor or if help is needed with the process, please contact any Task Force committee member. We want to make this process as user friendly as possible!

WOV PROJECT PROPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS

Go to ["WOVCharlotte.org"](http://WOVCharlotte.org)

In the grey window on the right, Click on "2009 Local Project Application Available". It is the first link under "WOV Charlotte Latest News".

Click on "Apply Now".

Follow these steps:

Step 1a - Download the 2009/10 Proposal Cover Letter in a Microsoft Word or PDF format.

Step 1b - Download the 2009/10 Local Project Proposal.

Note: It is important to download, save, and print both the cover letter and the proposal application so that the organization submitting the proposal can gather the information and documents required for the proposal.

Step 2 - Complete the Proposal.

Go into the saved proposal document and complete.

Note: The person completing the proposal must save the document to his/her computer so that it will be available to upload, which he/she will do as part of Step 3. Ideally, supporting documents should be available to submit electronically. It may be necessary to submit in hard copy one or more of the required attachments (such as an Annual Report). If possible, we prefer that all other information be submitted online.

Step 3 - Upload the Completed Proposal Online

Note: Once the proposal has been completed and saved and the supporting documents are saved, the actual transmission is accomplished in Step 3. Complete the required fields and electronically attach the proposal form and the supporting documents.
